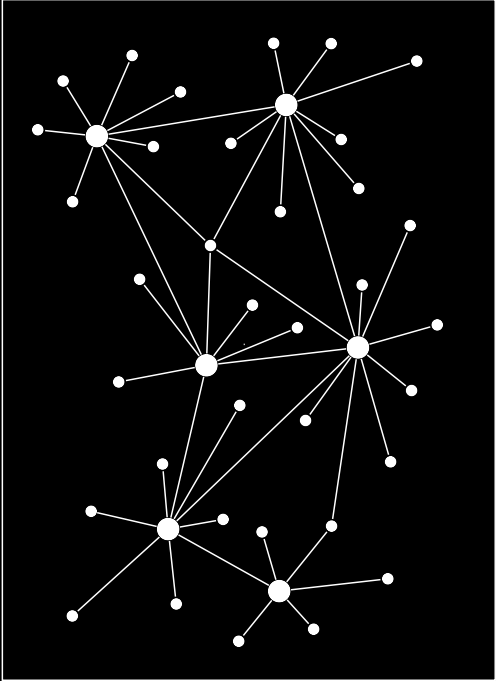


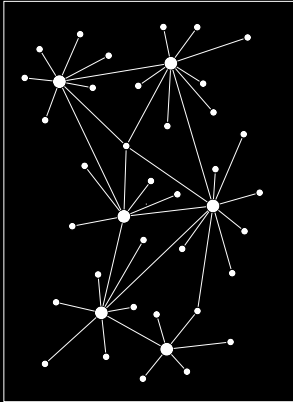


Centralised network

- ▶ Network behaviour

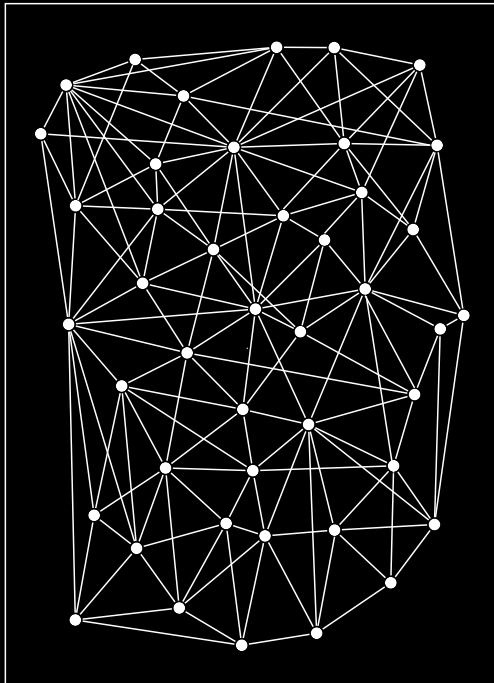


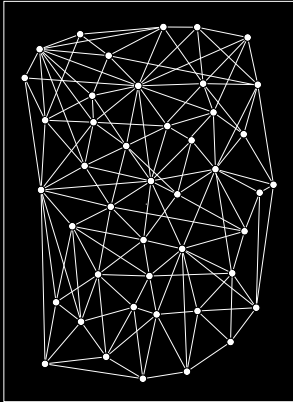


Decentralised network
